Entry Fee: \$40.00 per team (\$80.00 for boys and girls)

Scoring: Each team may enter seven (7) runners with the first five (5) scoring. Ties will be broken by the placing of the teams' sixth place runners.

I.H.S.A.A. Modifications:

- 1. Runners will be disqualified on the second false start.
- 2. Shoes which have rubber or leather soles must be worn by all contestants during the event. Cleats are permitted. A contestant shall be disqualified when both shoes are off.
- 3. No sun visors, sweat bands, caps, or hats shall be worn during the race.
- 4. Referee/Starter may allow contestants to wear stocking caps when the weather warrants.
