The Covid pandemic has required us to adjust our schedules. Next year, we may consider extending our meet and possibly even changing the date. For now, this is what works best for our program. Again, we hope you will consider competing at our meet.

Field Event Start Time: 10 AM

Running Events: 10:45 AM

Team Fee: \$60/team or \$110 for both boys and girls teams. Make checks payable to JHS Athletics.

Masks: Coaches and athletes will be required to wear masks. Athletes make take off masks when competing.

Entry Instructions: Submit entries to reddevils.milesplit.com Entries close April 5th at 6 PM. Two athletes/event. Athletes may **compete** in four events but can only be listed in six total events.

Seeding: Seeding information will be based upon Mile Split entries.

Finals: The top 8 athletes will advance to the finals in the 100/110 hurdles and 100 meters. This will include three/heat and the next two fastest times.

Field Events: Shot Put - girls first, Discus - boys first, Long Jump - boys first, High Jump - girls first, Pole Vault - girls first. Four attempts in SP, DS, and LJ. No Triple Jump. No jump finals.

Shot/Disc Weigh-in: Your implements will be weighed upon arrival.

Team Set-up: Tents and coolers will be allowed on the outside perimeter of the track but will not be permitted on the turf football field. Teams are encouraged to space out as much as possible around the stadium.

Blocks: Please bring a pair of starting blocks to ensure we have enough to accommodate everyone.

Warm-up: All athletes may use the infield for warm-up. The infield is only for coaches and athletes. Please do not allow athletes to toss footballs or other items on the infield. We want to respect this event as a track and field competition only.

Check-in: All coaches will pick up a team packet upon entering the meet. The packet will contain a bib number, heat sheets and pins. Field Events athletes will check in at the respected event. All athletes in running events will check in at the table located mid-field. Please report on the first call.

Parking: Buses can drop off teams at the front of the stadium's main entrance. Then buses can proceed back towards Allison Lane and park up by the front of the school.

Timing/Scoring: We will utilize a fully automatic timing system to produce accurate and instant results available on the internet. Photo Finish Timing will run all timing. The top eight places will be scored (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1).

Awards: The winning girl and boy teams will receive a team trophy. Ribbons will be awarded to the top 8 finishers per event.
